II. 6:40pm Administrative Reports

A. Secretary's Report (Allison Tucker)

- 1. Action Item: Move to approve minutes from September 15 and May 25, 2022.

B. Treasurer's Report (Jenny Skidmore)

A dance held at the school would have to have insurance and students would expect to follow the behavior expectations of South Middle School. It would be unfortunate if someone gets caught up in the excitement and into enough trouble with the Administration that they cannot walk across the stage at graduation.
